

What is a Standard?

- You Need Standards in Order to Survive – There can be no improvement without standardization.
 - Effectively combines materials, workers, and equipment to produce efficiently
 - Establishes a routine
 - Establishes a relationship between the team member and the process
 - Provides a basis for continuous improvement
 - Baseline for current condition
 - Determine part assembly (identify and eliminate waste)
 - Determine acceptable quality levels







The Standard

- The Standard must be **ESTABLISHED**, **MAINTAINED**, and **IMPROVED**
- The Tools Visual Management and Clean + S

Clean + S(5S)

- All Team Members Must:
 - Follow Established Standards
 - Maintain a Place for Everything and Everything in its Place
 - Follow-up Daily to Confirm the Standard





Clean + S (5S) Defined

• Clean + S is the cornerstone pillar of MBUSI's Production System (everything with a place and everything in its place). A clean workplace is a safe workplace. As a visual management tool,

Clean + S highlights the abnormal condition for improvement.

Clean + S

C is Clear Out (Sift)

(Throw away unneeded things)

Identify what is needed and not needed. Then eliminate the unneeded things. This improves Safety, reduces waste, and is the first step toward making improvements.





As you can see, we have opportunities in all areas!







L is Locate (Sort)

• (Store in correct location)

This means to properly place and identify the remaining needed material. Everything has a place and everything in its place. This is the 1st step to *Visual Management*.

E is Educate

• (Team Members, importance of Clean + S)

Educate all Team Members on the importance of *Clean* + *S* and why it is important. Teach how *Clean* + *S* relates to all other parts of our *Production System*.




















A is Always Clean (Sustain)

• (Keep it clean once you clean it)

Once *Clean* + *S* has been applied keep it clean. It is much easier to do, and is critical to *Visual Management*.























N is Never Quit (Sustain)

• (Have self-discipline to keep Clean program going)

We all must have the discipline to keep Clean + S alive. Clean + S is the cornerstone of our Production System because it provides the first pillar in building the rest of the Production System and supports training and safety.

















S is Safety

• (Remember that a clean area is a safer area)


An awareness of *Safety* and *Safety* issues must always be present when implementing *Clean + S.* Remember *Safety* is the foundation for all the *Production System.*

- Contributes to a repeatable work cycle.
- Highlights abnormal conditions (visual management).

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













